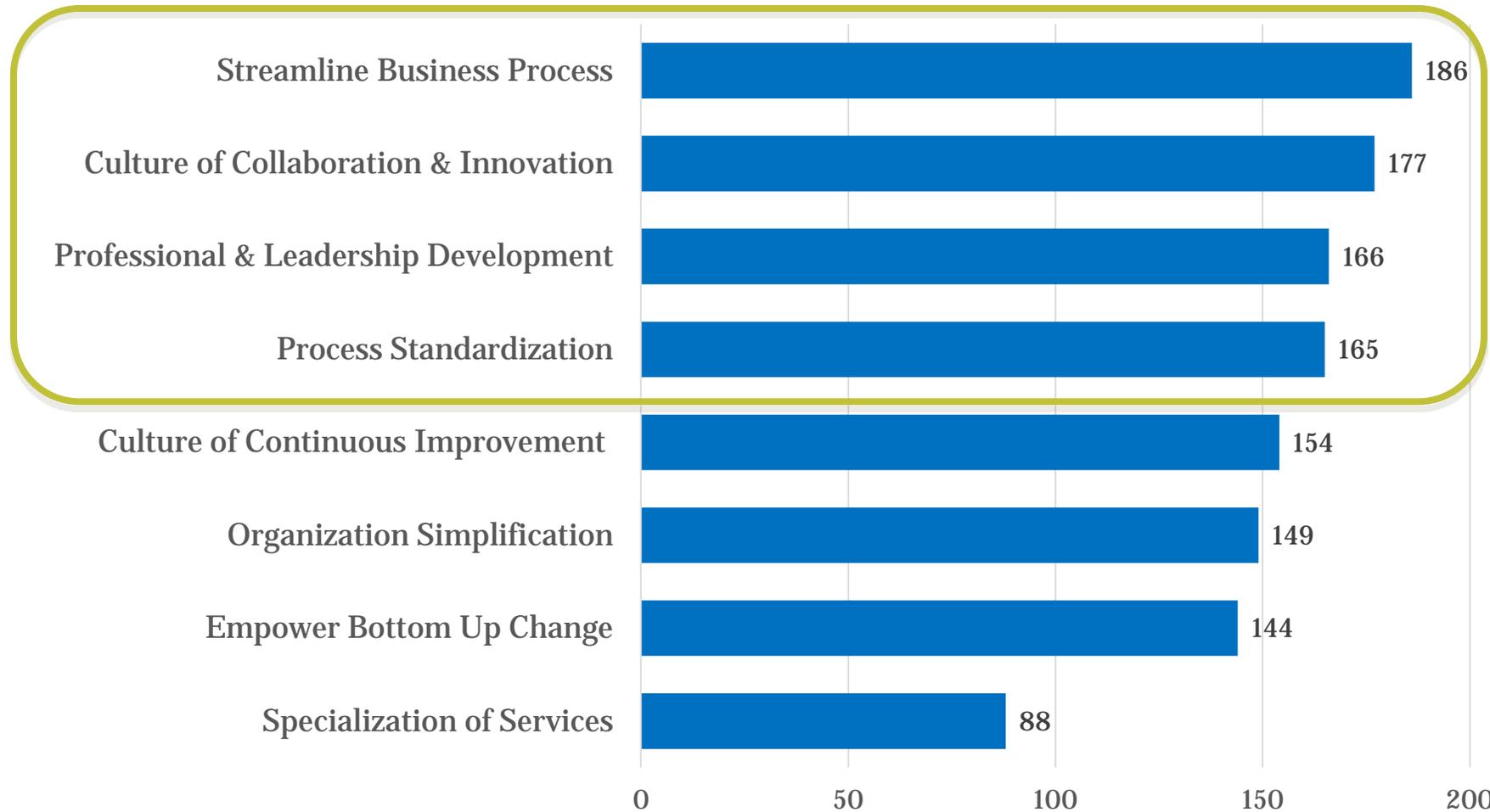

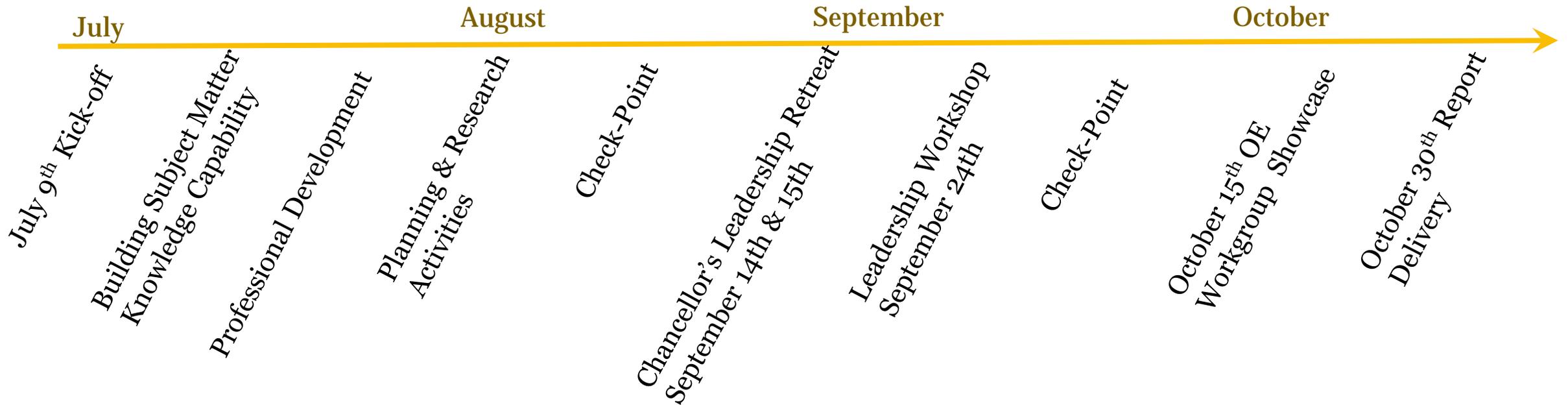

Report Outline

The report is envisioned to contain the following sections:

Executive Summary	Summarize the key points of the workgroup's OE Initiative report by defining what the research is, why it was conducted and the purpose of it in 2- 3 paragraphs.
Vision, Goals, & Objectives	Define the workgroup's the vision of the OE Initiative research, and outline the goals and objectives of the report.
Framework	Use the framework section to guide the research. It will define the elements that the report will measure, and the statistical relationships the report will evaluate to support the research.
Analysis	Provide a detailed examination and explanation of the elements that the report measures and define the structure of the workgroup 's OE initiative goals.
Recommendations	Provide recommendations on how to best achieve the goals of the OE initiative that your workgroup has been researching.
Proposed Plan	Provide a detailed plan outlining on how to implement the recommendations of your report to support the framework, vision, goals and objectives of your OE initiative.
